Dorothy Hull Library Windsor Charter Township Library Board Minutes August 13, 2020

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic restrictions, the following meeting was conducted over ZOOM and telephone.

Present: Robbins, Runels (by phone), Gould, Wood, Kyler, Sanders, Wagemaker

Excused Absence: Watson

President Robbins called the meeting to order at 6:12 p.m.

Public Comment: None

Minutes: Motion by Runels, support Wood to approve the minutes of July 9, 2020 as presented. Motion Carried: 5-0

Reports:

- a. Financial Reports: Penal Fines were not recorded on the July report but will be about \$4,000 less than anticipated.
 - Motion by Wood, support Runels to accept financial reports pending audit. Motion Carried 5-0
- b. Circulation Report: Activity was increased in the area of reference questions and ebooks which exceeded every other library in the co-op!
- c. Director's Report: Library staff will do setup for the upcoming StoryWalk.
- d. LM Library Law webinar. Robbins gave a brief summary. Gould did not think much of the information applied to our own library. There was agreement that at the time when and if a new building is possible, an attorney would be advisable.

Unfinished Business:

- a. Library of Michigan CARES Act Grant for PPE: Sanders reported that the library received \$500, which was more than the \$350 requested. The money is being used for sanitizing supplies and personal protective equipment due to the pandemic.
- b. Addendum to Personnel Policy regarding work from home: Tabled until September
- c. Update to COVID-19 Response Policy: Tabled until September

New Business:

- a. Lending mobile hotspots. Cost of such was discussed. Wood made a motion to talk with area schools to determine if that is a service they are covering. Support Gould. Further discussion. Sanders will canvass local businesses for possible support. Wood withdrew her motion.
- b. Repairs to furnace room door and pressure tank. Sanders reported that a new pressure tank would cost between \$850 and \$900. She said it was decided to pay \$250 for repair, and so far so good.

The furnace door needs a crash bar and lock. Sanders will further explore costs for hardware and installation.

Other issues:

A wireless printer was purchased with funds from an anonymous donor. There was some discussion on budget and how the township's budget might affect library funding.
