- b. Circulation Report: Sanders reported that the largest activity was in the ebook category, business being affected by the COVID-19 Pandemic restrictions.
- c. Director's Report: Sanders reported that included with other activities, Large Print inventory and weeding has been completed. Sanders also reported that the Dimondale Business Association has proposed supporting a StoryWalk in the downtown area

Unfinished Business: The Personnel Policy is informational only and is tabled for the next meeting. Included in today's packet are file copies of approved policies.

New Business:

(a) With receipt of the 2019 Audit Runels suggested a letter be written to the Township Clerk and Treasurer thanking them for the work performed.

- (b) Library of Michigan CARES Act Grant Application. The money would be used for gloves, masks, and other necessary supplies needed during this COVID-19 timeframe.
- (c) Mobile Beacon WI-FY Lending Launch Kit Grant Application. Sanders explained the grant implications. There was concern that although free at the onset, future costs might prove prohibitive.
